### **DID YOU REPORT IT TO THE POLICE?**

*The police are constantly and continuously asking the public to report every suspicious incident to them, or to the authority responsible.*

#### **WHY is it so important?**

*Because every small piece of information is like one, tiny piece of a jig-saw. Without that little piece, it is impossible to see, or understand the whole picture.*

*That one, small bit may be the key to the puzzle, indeed, it may be the final clue that enables the police to solve a much larger, more serious crime.*

*When something small happens, we cannot know its significance, and we may never know, for the police cannot reveal sensitive information to anyone.*

*COMMON SENSE tells us that reporting something suspicious, or strange, must always be the "right thing to do."*

*People do not report crime for many reasons. The 101 non-urgent police line is nearly always busy, and members of the public understandably grow tired of waiting, and waiting, and waiting for an answer.*

*A better, quicker way to report an incident, or crime that has already happened is to ring Crimestoppers on 0800 555 111  
They will pass on all the details you give them to the police.  
Or email the police at [101@dc.police.uk](mailto:101@dc.police.uk)  
If it is happening RIGHT NOW, then it is 999*

*We are all aware that the police force is suffering from massive spending cuts. HOWEVER, it is not in anyone's interest that crime should go unchallenged and unpunished.*

**AND THIS IS WHY THE POLICE WANT YOU TO TELL THEM**  
**WHAT IS GOING ON IN YOUR AREA.**

*Often, local crime can be controlled, or even eradicated by police patrols.  
By repeatedly reporting incidents of crime, no matter how small,  
the statistics will rise and an argument can then be made for an extra officer in that  
area to sort out the problem for the residents.*

***HELP YOURSELF, AND YOUR COMMUNITY BY REPORTING CRIME.  
WORK TOGETHER WITH YOUR NEIGHBOURS TO  
DEFEAT CRIME.***

*If it is happening RIGHT NOW, ring 999.*

*If it has happened and the culprits have gone,  
try 101 at a time when the line is not busy,  
because if it has already happened and the culprits have disappeared,  
there is no real urgency for your report and you can take your time,  
ensuring that you report every detail.*
